A top business destination, Barcelona hosts global events every year such as Mobile World Congress and the Smart City Expo World Congress.



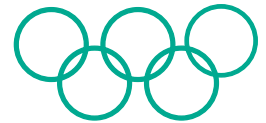
A city of big business, Barcelona is a base for top international companies including Amazon, eDreams, Inditex and HP.
